Development Activities

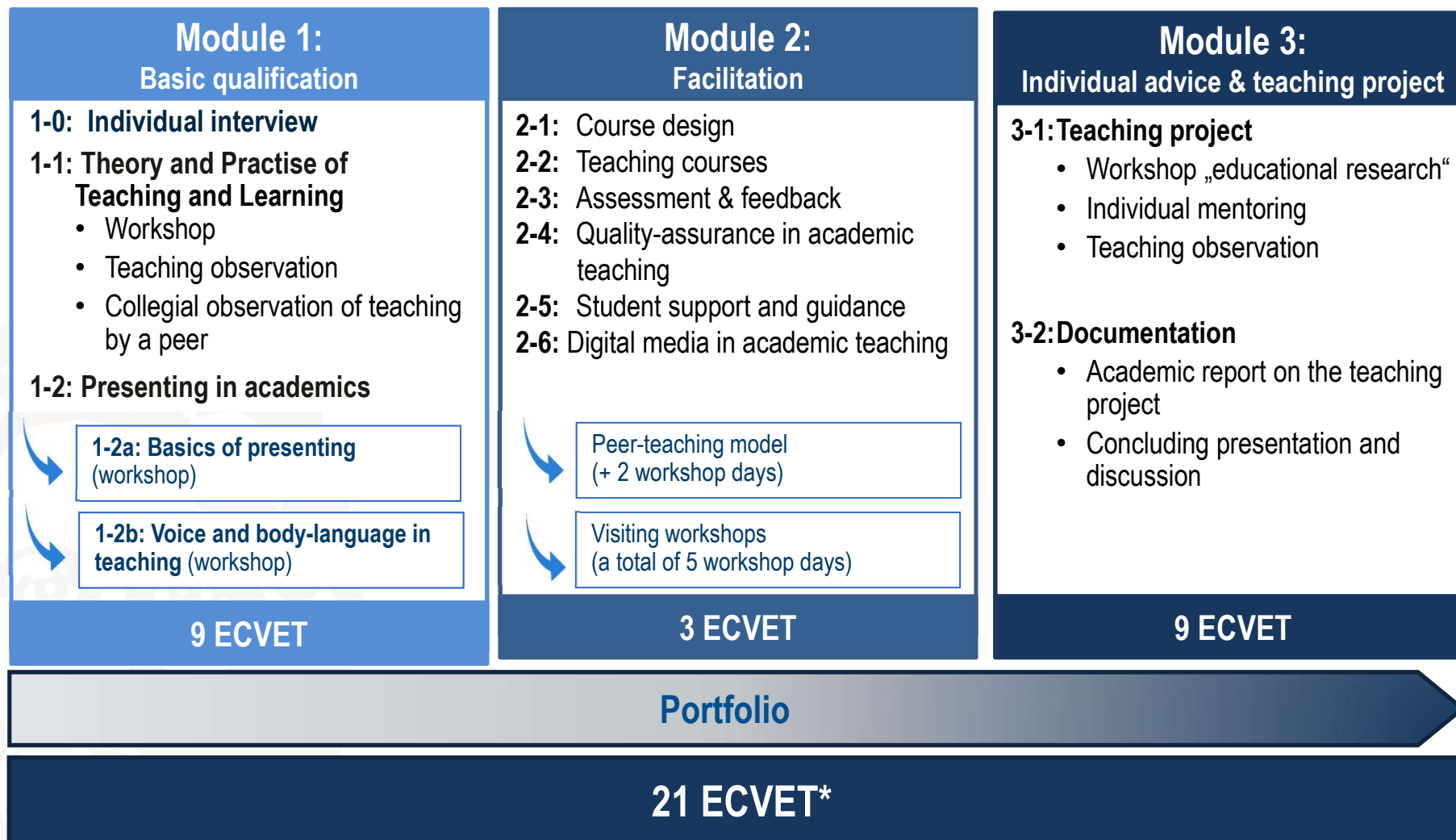
- **Individual Level**
